Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943. They started out as a small machine shop at first employing 4 people. Sales for their initial year of operation totaled 60 thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless steel valves, pipe fittings and different parts. Through five years of operation, the business had stretched to 40 employees and their annual sales volume had risen to \$330,000. Now, Cascade is amongst the top global makers within the material handling trade.

Manufacture and design of the company's initial hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive pursuit of better business opportunities. During the past 60 years, the material handling business has developed into a very sophisticated field and Cascade has proudly performed a part in this improvement. Cascade at present continues to grow as the leader supplier of forklift accessories and various related items. The company feels certain in their capability to be able to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding customer's requirements in the future and remaining competitive in the global market.

All through the 1950's, Cascade began to make, design, and promote its hydraulic accessories. A new facility was constructed in the year 1956, to be able to house all the plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which is still the company's current center of operations. Subsequent to fifteen years of business, total workers reached one hundred eighty workers and sales had reached nearly \$2,300,000.

The next production plant was built in the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. 1960 marked Cascade's initial transfer into the international world of the material handling industry while the business established interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

In 1964, the business altered its name to the Cascade Corporation. Afterward in the year 1965, the company went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Ever since then the business has expanded its manufacturing facilities throughout the continental USA to the areas Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already present plants in Springfield, Ohio and Portland, Oregon. Cascade products are made internationally because of many subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European head office. This facility is made to be the ultimate customer support centre.

Continuing to develop, Cascade expanded their product offering further in the year 1996 and the year 1997 with the dramatic acquisition of 5 companies, along with the global best in forks, the Kenhar Corporation.
